**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Clerk of the Board of Education shall have and is hereby granted the authority to make alternate or substitute appointments of custodians, as the necessity arises; and that all persons being so named and designated as being qualified to serve as custodian by the Town of Deerpark and the City of Port Jervis, New York for the preceding General Election be and they hereby are appointed alternate or substitute voting machine custodian to act in the place and stead of any regularly appointed custodian, who, for any reason, shall be unable to fulfill their duties. The Clerk of the Board of Education shall be relieved of the obligation to give written notice of appointment to any alternate or substitute custodian selected to serve.
