

NYS has become very strict on Sec 211 waivers. Currently, the district employs a substitute monitor that is a retired police officer. The monitor will not exceed the threshold but a Sec 211 waiver is required - just in case. Earlier last year (around October) a waiver was submitted. The local Civil Service provided the district with an old form. In November or December, the state provided me with the new form. The employee signed the form, I signed the form. The state will not accept the form until and unless: 1) the BoE takes formal action to allow the Superintendent of Schools to file the waiver and then 2) the Superintendent of Schools signs the form.

I will prepare an agenda item and follow the process.
